### TIPS TO HELP YOU KEEP YOUR PLEDGE

1. Turn off your phone before you start your car.
2. Mute the ringer or 'new message' alert tone.
3. Place your phone beyond the reach of the driver's position.
4. Ask a passenger to hold/answer your phone.
5. Ask your passengers to remind you of your pledge.
6. Change your voice message to inform callers that you will not answer calls or texts while driving.
7. Make your last-minute calls before entering your car.
8. Place a pledge reminder sticker on your dashboard.
9. Ask your family and friends to avoid calling you during your normal commute times.
10. If you must take a call, find a safe place to pull over before you start the conversation.
11. If all else fails, wear gloves so it's too difficult to press the phone's keys.
